This annual workshop aims to bring together researchers investigating issues of relevance to current public policy. We invite submissions from all fields of applied microeconomics, including (but not restricted to): labor, health and development economics, economics of education, and demography.

This year, one session will be devoted to topics related to "Health, Wealth and Inequality" and one session will be devoted to topics concerning "Health Shocks, Medical Innovations and Treatments." Examples of suitable topics include:

The papers should pay particular attention to the identification of causal relationships using rigorous econometric techniques. The workshop will last for one day. The number of participants is limited to 25, with a maximum of 8-10 invited and contributed papers. The workshop program, travel and accommodation assistance will be provided on the workshop webpage. Participation is free of charge and includes registration, breakfast, lunch, and refreshments. Participants are expected to cover their own transportation and accommodation costs (if needed).
