The main library is based in Odense, a city of 180.000 inhabitants, where LIBER 2022 will take place, but geographically the library with six campuses and a staff of 100 spans the entire southern Danish region from Copenhagen in the east to Esbjerg 300 km in the west, and Sønderborg close to the German border.
