

The new submission option is called **Quick Submit** and you will find it alongside our other submission options in Pure for research output. We will still add research automatically when possible. **Quick Submit** can make it less time-consuming to add the research we do not add on your behalf. The files you chose to upload will be shared according to publisher's terms - if any sharing is allowed. We thus encourage the upload of accepted manuscripts for open access when you add your research. If your uploaded files do not contain information on where it is or will be published please specify in the Notes section.
