The DARE Fellowship Programme takes Danish medical students to the San Francisco Bay Area for ten months to receive hands-on training in clinical research. Participants are closely mentored by internationally recognised clinical researchers at some of America's finest academic institutions, UCSF and Stanford.

The programme is a partnership between the Lundbeck Foundation and Innovation Centre Denmark, based in Silicon Valley. This unique international partnership gives Danish medical students the opportunity to jumpstart their careers in medical research and entrepreneurship.
