# Label Guide

Confused about all the labels, you can find in the Danish super markets? Here you can find a guide about, what the different labels mean.



## The Danish label for organic food

Organic food can be labelled with "Ø-mærket", which is your guarantee for organic production and animal welfare. All products labelled with "Ø-mærket" have been statecontrolled.



#### The Nordic nutrition logo

Nøglehulsmærket, the nutrition logo, is to guide consumers to find healthier foods. Foods that contribute to a healthy and varied diet may come with this green keyhole logo.



### The Nordic ecolabel

Non-food products that are among the least environmentally damaging can be designated with the Nordic ecolabel, "Svanemærket"



## The allergy label

Products with this label are hypoallergenic. All of these products are perfume and paraben free and are certified by the Danish Asthma and Allergy Association.

#### Deposits on returnable packaging

In Denmark, you pay a deposit on most beer and soft drink. They are marked with a label similar to the one shown here. Recyclable containers can be returned at most supermarkets, where you will receive your deposit.





#### Smiley

All Danish companies that either sell, produce and/or are handling food need to have a Smiley from the Danish Veterinary and Food Administration. It shows how well the company is living up to the food standard/rules. You can always ask to see their Smiley rating.



#### Whole grain

This logo means that you can be sure that all parts of the grain need to be remained in the product. It also has a limitation to how much sugar, fat and salt there can be added in the product. You can find the logo on bread (e.g. rye bread), flour, breakfast products, rice and pasta.



#### Animal well-being

If animal well-being is important to you this logo is the one to look for. Especially with pork meat. The hearts mean that the pig has not got it's tale cut off or bid in by other pigs. This often happens, when the pig has too little space or is stressed. The pigs have had more space, and they have had access to straw. If the logo has three hearts, it means that the pig is organic and has been living outdoor.



#### EU ecolabel

The Flower is the official EU ecolabel. It is used for non-food products. In Denmark it is mainly seen on clothing, paint, shampoo and soap. Like the Danish "Svanemærket".



# Forest Stewardship Council (FSC)

The Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) is an international, nongovernmental organization dedicated to promoting responsible management of the world's forests. FSC's "tick tree" logo is used to indicate that products are certified under the FSC system. When you see the FSC logo on a label, you can buy forest products with confidence that you are helping to ensure our forests are alive for generations to come.











# 14 specialties from Denmark

Here you can find a list of Danish specialties, if you are looking to try some typical Danish dishes.

**Rygeost:** smoked fresh cheese sometimes produced with cumin

Æbleflæsk: apple sauce and bacon

**Frikadeller:** a kind of a meatball without any other spices than salt and pepper and in some variants finely chopped onions

Smørrebrød: ryebread with cold cuts

**Rødgrød med fløde:** stewed red berry fruits with cream

Flæskesteg: roasted pork

Leverpostej med agurk, rødbede eller asier: liver paté often served with cucumber, pickled beetroot or chunky pickled cucumber

Biksemad: a kind of hash

Medisterpølse: Danish pork sausage

Hakkebøf med bløde løg: minced beef steak with caramelized onions

Æggekage med tomat, bacon or purløg: Danish omelet with tomatoes, bacon and chive

**Tarteletter:** Patty shells with e.g. boiled chicken and white asparagus

**Klar suppe:** Clear soup with meat balls, vegetables (carrots and celeriac) and dumplings

**Stegt flæsk med persillesovs og kogte kartofler:** Fried pork with parsley sauce and boiled potatoes. This dish was elected as the Danes favorite national dish in 2014.
