How to open a bank account

Please remember to bring the following documentation to the bank of your choice:

- Your passport,
- CPR-number (the temporary document received from the International Citizen Service Center or your yellow card, if you have already received that)
- Employment contract or official invitation letter, if you are a guest researcher/PhD
- US citizens only: social security card

When opening a bank account, you can tell the bank advisor that you would like to receive information in English. Otherwise you will receive the information in Danish.

You can also mention that you are an SDU employee or associated with SDU to smooth the process of opening an account.

Please note that you need your yellow card to get access to online banking.

You need a Nem-ID to open a bank account and use online banking. The Nem-ID is used for public services and online banking, so you can get it both at the International Citizen Service Center and the bank. Let the bank know, if you already have a Nem-ID, as you should not register for another one. Read more about Nem-ID at: www.nemid.nu/dk-en/about_nemid.
