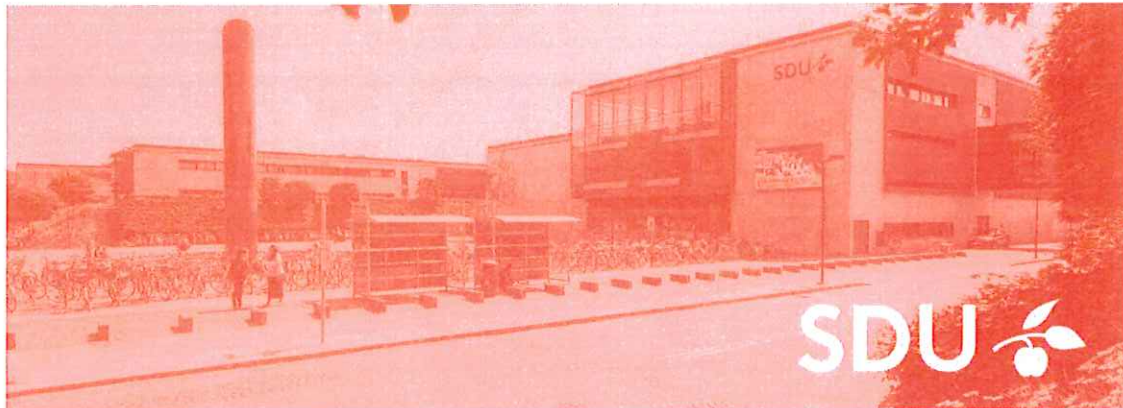

Hopefully you have had a wonderful Christmas and a happy New Year! 2017 calls for a new start and therefore I have changed the newsletter layout. I hope you like it!

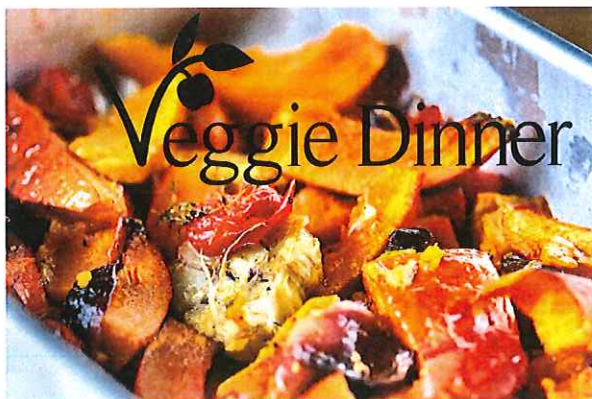
Veggie dinner 11 of January at 6:30pm
