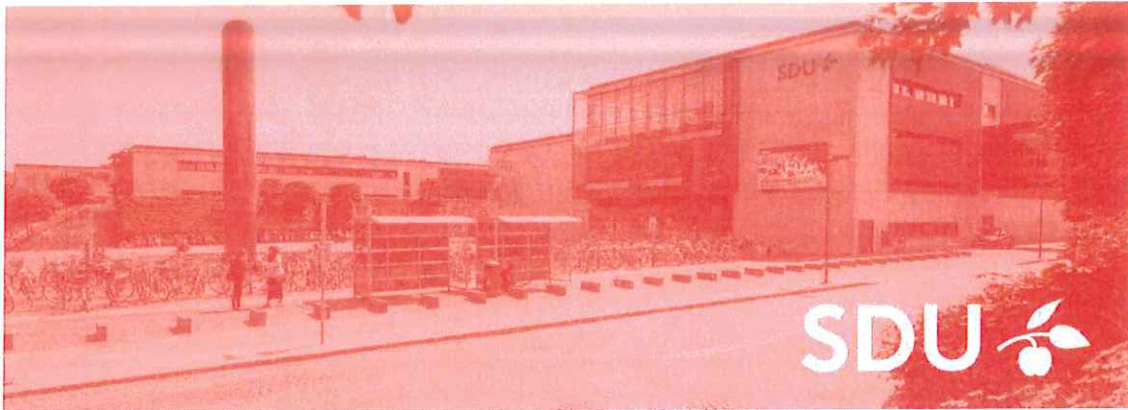

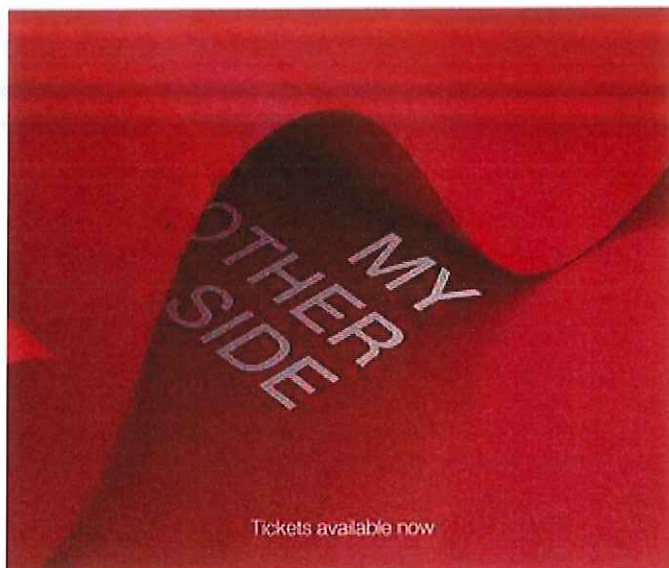
TEDxOdense is returning to Odense Theater on April 14th!

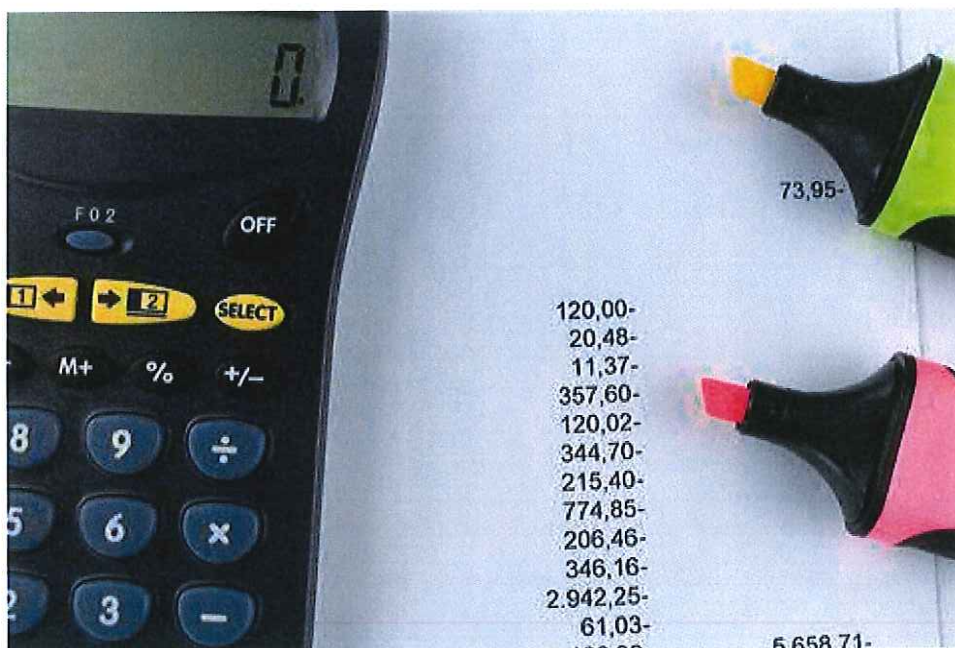
