The International Club is organising a fantastic trip to Bornholm, to take place between 12<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> September, when the weather should still be quite warm. We will depart from Odense in the morning of Friday 12<sup>th</sup> and arrive back on Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> in the evening.

You will get to see some of the most beautiful and amazing nature that Denmark has to offer! We will visit some of the well-known sights of Bornholm and enjoy the famous treasures of the Island. In the evening, we will relax at the lovely hotel have some social activities!

**Do not miss out on this great opportunity to see a very unique part of Denmark.**

*NOTE: To keep the price down, the International Club has agreed to subsidise the trip by paying for the bus transport from Odense to Ystad and return.*

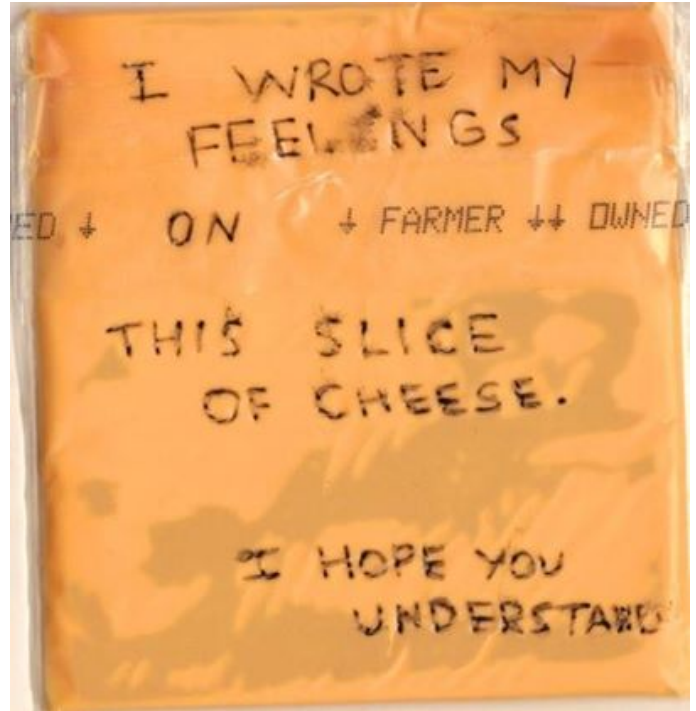
The total price for the trip will be between 1650 kr. and 1950 kr. per person, depending on if you are sharing a room.

This very reasonable price includes the return journey to Bornholm including the ferry, 2 nights in the hotel by the sea, all breakfasts, lunches and dinners (excl. drinks), entrance fees to the sights and the guided tour of Bornholm.

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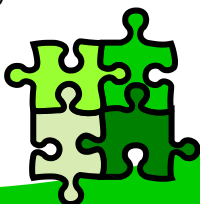

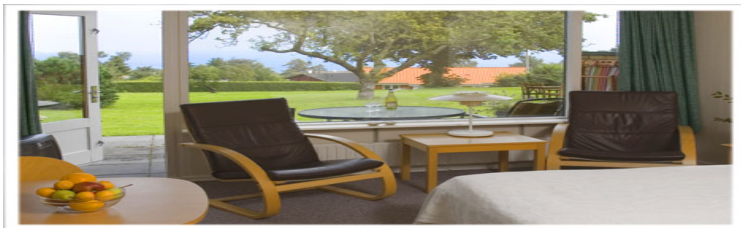




## Come with the SDU international club to the Sunshine Island of Bornholm!

### Programme – Friday 12/9/2014

- 07.30 Departure from Dannebrogsgade 5, 5000 Odense C.
- 12.30 Ferry from Ystad to Rønne. Bring your own lunch or buy it on the ferry.
- 14.00 Arrive on Bornholm. We will start at Bornholm's Technical Museum. Have a look at: [www.bornteksamling.dk](http://www.bornteksamling.dk)
- 16.45 Arrive at the hotel, which is right by the ocean. Have a look at: [www.teambornholm.dk/hotelKlintely](http://www.teambornholm.dk/hotelKlintely). There will be some free time before dinner to enjoy the wonderful hotel surroundings.



- 19.00 Two course dinner at the hotel restaurant.
- 21.30 Hammershus by night. An English-speaking guide will tell us about life at the fortress in the year 1600. Hammershus is Northern Europe's largest medieval fortification, situated 74 ms above sea level on the northern tip of Bornholm.
- 23.30 Good night and see you tomorrow!

### Saturday 13/9/2014

- 08.00 Breakfast at the hotel.
- 09.00 There is a guided tour around Bornholm arranged for the day. We will get to see and experience some of the most famous and well known sights that Bornholm has to offer: Ols round church, Ekkodalen (Echo Valley), Denmark's longest rift, stretching for 12 km, a natural phenomenon that was formed during the last ice age and Svaneke village, voted Danmark's most beautiful village.



We will eat lunch at the local brewery, and have a look in the small, unique shops that the village has to offer, including the place where they make the famous Danish liquorice "Lakrids".

Afterwards, we will visit another unique village, called Gudhjem, a small town and fishing port, situated on a cliff, and with a population of just 712 people.

19.00 Dinner at the hotel.

20.30 Enjoy some time together at the hotel playing games, dancing etc. You are welcome to bring along your guitar or other musical instruments :-)

### Sunday 14/9/2014

08.00 Breakfast at the hotel

10.00 Continuation of the guided tour around the Island, finishing by the ferry.  
We will see, among other things: The famous Bornholm Glassworks, Dueodder, a unique sand dune landscape where we will go for a little hike (2 km). For lunch we will try a traditional Bornholm fish buffet. Delicious!

14.30 Ferry back to Ystad.

19.00 Estimated arrival time in Odense.

Price per person is between 1650 kr. and 1950 kr., depending on if you share a room. Rooms will be allocated on a "first come, first served" basis. This very reasonable price includes also the ferry, all transfers and transport, all meals (breakfasts, lunches and dinners) and the guided tour/entry fees as well. Note, you may purchase your own drinks at meals.
