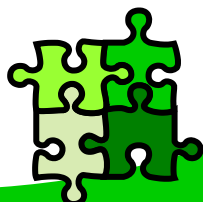
## ..things happen but we make sense of them..

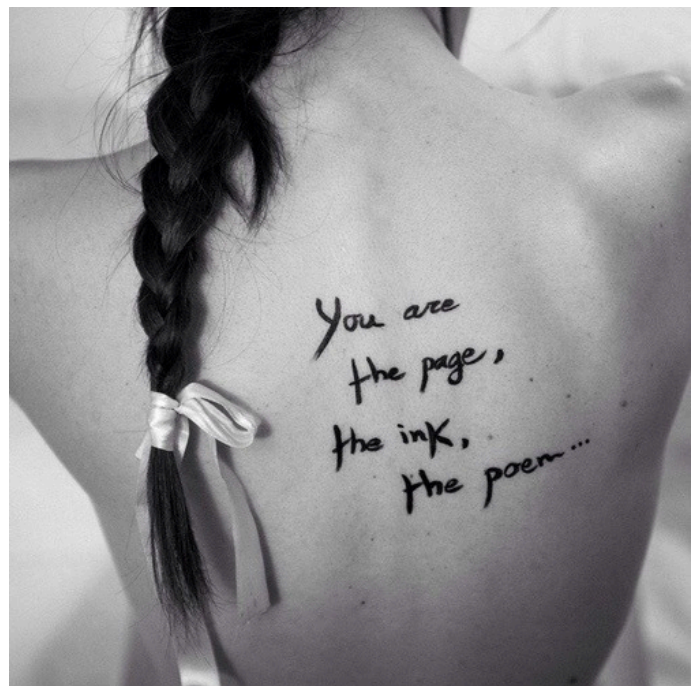
### Party on campus

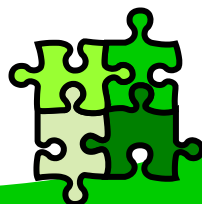
You have to be careful telling things.

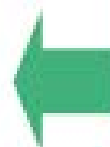
