Tired of going out to restaurants and not finding good meatless options?

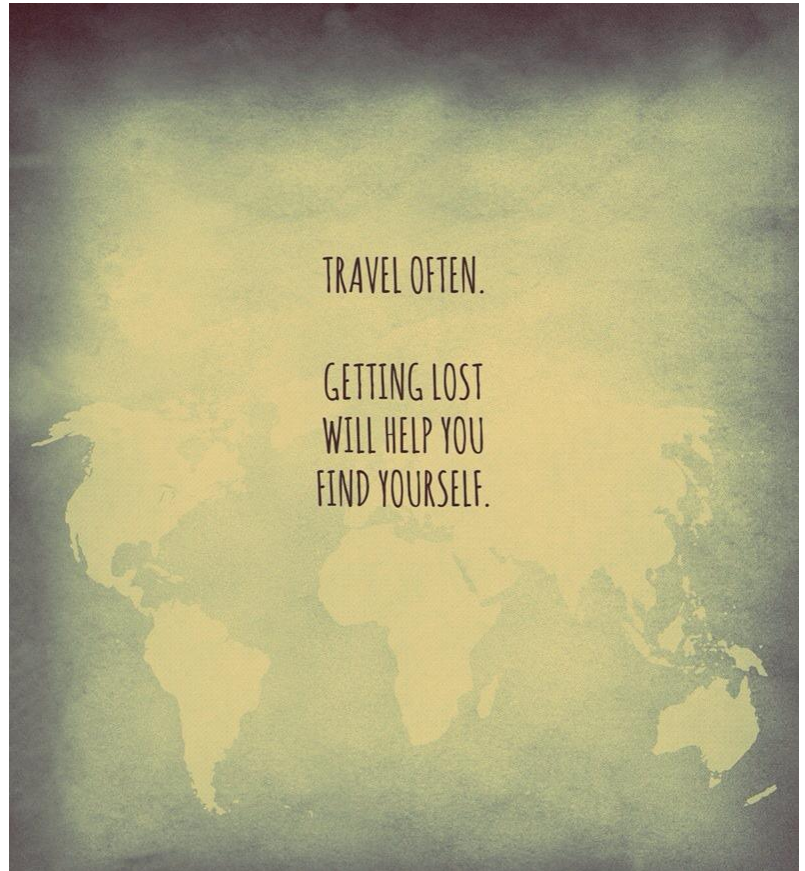
Join us for a vegetarian potluck dinner in Odense.

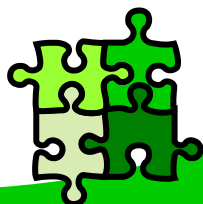

September 21/22

Hop off the island of Fyn and explore the infamous island of Møn

On the weekend of the 21-22 September we will travel from Funen (Fyn) to the idyllic island of Moen (Møn).

Don't miss out on this fantastic opportunity to see this infamous place in Denmark and share the experience with old and new friends.

Following the amazing success of past years' summer adventures in Denmark, including the most recent fabulous trip to Langeland, the International Club is organising another weekend trip to showcase more of Denmark's hidden treasures.

This family friendly trip aims to unveil one of Denmark's most famous landmarks: Møns Klint . These bright chalk cliffs stretch some 6 km from the park of Liselund in the north to the lighthouse in the south. Some of the cliffs fall a sheer 120 m to the sea below. The area around Møns Klint consists of woodlands, pastures, ponds and steep hills. The cliffs are protected as a nature reserve. Some 250,000 people visit Møns Klint each year.

There are clearly marked paths for walkers, riders and cyclists. The path along the cliff tops provides impressive views and leads to steps down to the shore.

We will have an opportunity to spend a whole day visiting the incredible Geocentre as well as a day visiting the nearby beautiful Liseland park and the historical merchant town of Stege.

We will spend the night on the shores of Lake Hunosø, a 15 minute walk from the Cliffs of Møn at Danhostel. All rooms at Danhostel Møns Klint have shared bathrooms. The price for a 4 bed room plus buffet dinner and buffet breakfast is 445 kr (adults) and 295 kr (children over under 12), children under 2 go free. The International Club will cover the cost of transport (bus), but individuals are responsible for the cost of food (lunch both days) and accommodation (which includes dinner and breakfast). The bus will depart ca. 09.00 on Saturday morning and return ca. 16.00 on Sunday afternoon.
