

Mortens aften (the evening of Saint Martin) the 10th of Nov.

The goose became a symbol of St. Martin of Tours because of the legend that when trying to avoid being ordained bishop, Martin had hidden in a goose pen, where he was betrayed by the cackling of the geese).

In Denmark, *Mortens Aften* is celebrated with traditional dinners, while the day itself (St. Martins Day the 11th November) is rarely recognized. Nowadays the goose is most often replaced with a duck due to size, taste and/or cost.

It will be possible to eat a traditional "Mortens aften" dinner in most of the restaurants in the city.

Light on the Christmas tree

The light on the huge Christmas tree at Flakhaven will be turned on 5 weeks before Christmas evening, which is celebrated the 24th December in Denmark.
