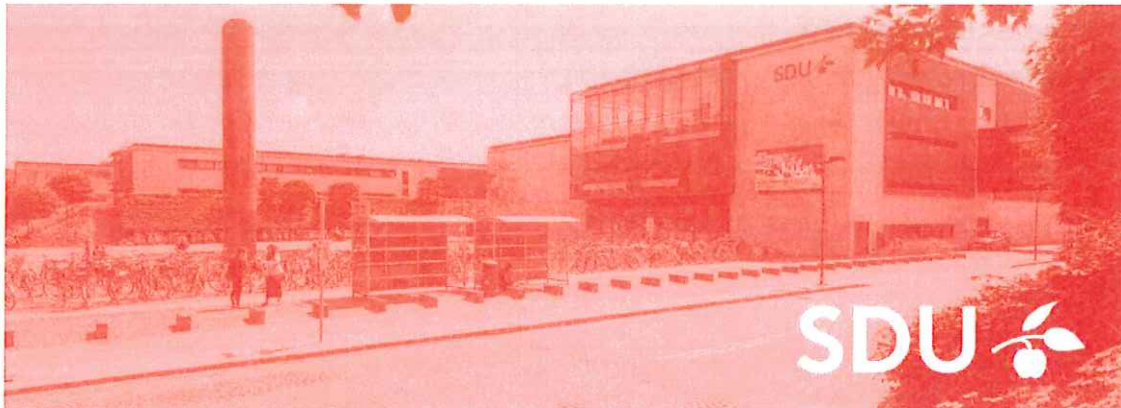

This month we will talk about Danish superstitions and myths since it is soon Halloween. We will also talk about Danish news and what is going on in Odense.

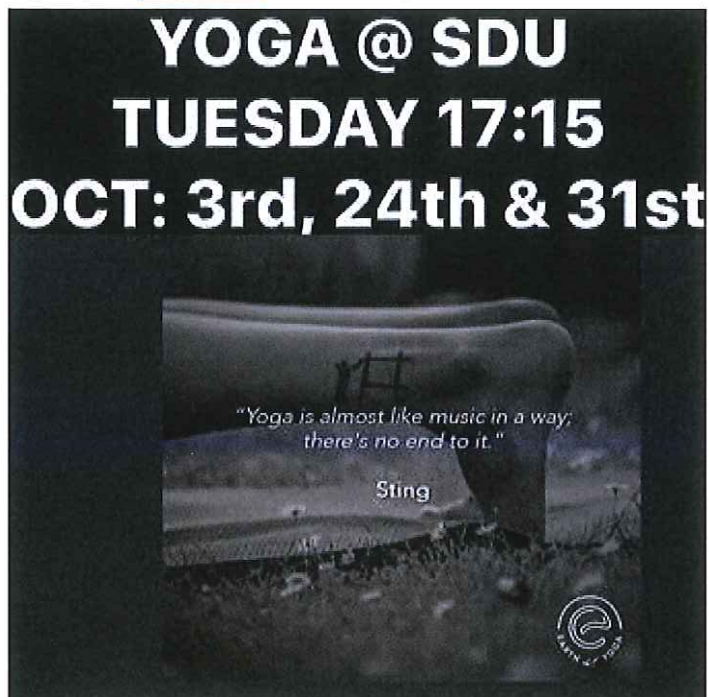
Place to be: Wintergarden opposite the canteen4. No need to sign up.

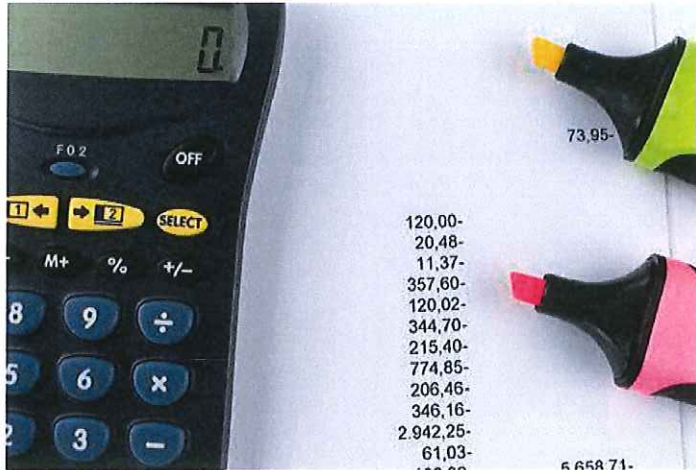
