This year it is also the 50th anniversary of SDU, so there will be even more to celebrate!

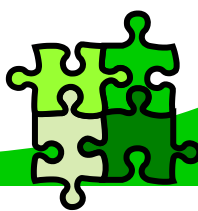
There will be live music all over campus, so go out and enjoy an evening together with your colleagues at the **Party of the Year!**
