Conference aim

The aim of the conference is to share, document, demonstrate, substantiate, and analyse experiences of active teaching and learning. We hope to inspire refinement of current practice and development of new practices within active teaching and learning.

Conference theme: *Teaching for Active Learning* - with a special focus on:

Group work – formats, function, facilitation, and effect on learning and well-being

TAL2023 welcomes abstracts on all aspects of both “activating teaching and learning” and “group work”. The conference targets both online and physical presence in groupwork together with a broad variety of interactions and roles. Examples to inspire you for your abstract themes are:

- Students’ professional and/or personal development through group work
- Student partnership in developing different group work formats
- Instruments, methods, and challenges for facilitation and for improving students’ motivation and competences to work in groups in and out of class – tools and good practice
- Students' different roles in the group
- Interdisciplinary group work
- Exam formats for assessing students’ group work competences
- Helping staff and faculty implementing effective groupwork in different practices

Abstracts

You may submit abstracts for either a short communication, a poster, or a workshop. You may choose to submit and present in either Danish or in English.

Deadline for submission of abstracts: 30 May.

In the **short communication** sessions, each presenter will have 10 minutes to share a teaching experience and reflections followed by 10 minutes of discussion.

Poster presentations will be held in Campustorvet with 5 minutes presentations followed by short discussions.

Workshops, up to 1 hour, need to be participant activating, and the abstract will have to indicate how.

Abstracts must be submitted in Word format: See the [conference webpage](#) for abstract information and download of abstract templates.

All abstracts will be peer reviewed prior to acceptance or rejection.

Presenters will subsequently have the possibility of submitting a paper on their presentation for the conference proceedings.

Conference language: The morning keynote will be in English. There will be parallel sessions in English and in Danish.
