

DaWS Early Career Workshop 2020, May 4-5: Call for Applications

The Danish Center for Welfare Studies (DaWS) calls for applications from advanced PhD students and early career researchers for the **DaWS Early Career Workshop 2020**. The workshop is broadly focused on welfare research, with quantitative, qualitative and theoretical contributions welcome.

This workshop will give you the opportunity to present your work to our senior faculty as well as a small group of selected international early career researchers (up to 6 years after completion of PhD). Each presenter gets a slot of 45 minutes including discussion and an assigned discussant from our senior faculty, so we aim to offer intense feedback as well as great networking opportunities. Full papers should be sent around to discussants and participants 2 weeks in advance.

The DaWS Early Career Workshop takes place **May 4-5 2020 at the University of Southern Denmark in Odense**. The organizers will cover all expenses, including travel, accommodation and a workshop dinner.
