Guest Account Guidelines at the University of Southern Denmark (SDU)

Everyone using the IT-facilities of the University of Southern Denmark (SDU) will need to comply with the IT Regulations of the University, because

- we want to preserve our good name and reputation
- we want to make sure that our shared knowledge is kept safe and secure
- it is for our mutual benefit - now and in the future

Below, you can read what you need to know about SDU's IT security to use your guest account.

- Your guest account allows you to access the Internet from SDU's network. You have no access to SDU's internal systems.
- Your guest account is strictly personal. You will be held personally responsible for all actions taken while using that account.
- It is not allowed to use your guest account for irresponsible or illegal purposes. This means that,
 - it is not allowed to copy or distribute copyrighted materials such as music, films or software
 - attempts at sending harassing, obscene and/or threatening messages to other users, are not allowed
 - it is not allowed to delete, read, copy or modify any other person's data without the other person's permission to do so
 - attempts to gain unauthorized access to SDU's or remote systems, are not allowed
 - any attempts at disrupting the performance of SDU's network and/or other networks, are not allowed
 - it is not allowed to scan SDU's network for network addresses, open ports or services.
 - attempts at sending unwanted ads (spam) or similar kind of message, are not allowed
 - it is not allowed to use third-part IT-facilities or services, unless SDU's licenses allow guests to use those facilities and/or services.
