

# Social Games Against Crime Seminar 27 - 28 sept 2018

Over the past 3 years the Social Games Against Crime research project has studied how social games can help improve relationships between children and their incarcerated fathers in Danish prisons.

We wish to invite researchers and practitioners from social design, criminology and narrative studies to a 2-day seminar, to share experiences and results and to discuss the challenges and potentials of design research interventions to strengthen family bonds and well-being of children of incarcerated fathers.
