Kick-off and presentation of the challenge on the first day. Presentation of the proposed solution to the company and stakeholders on the last day.

• SPIN IN LONG SPRINT:

Duration 6 weeks

Wednesday the 7th of October to Friday 18th of November 2020.

There will be 4 meetings during the period. We work together - but separately.

Kick-off and presentation of the challenge in the company on the first day, 2 online meetings in the weeks following and finally presentation of the solution in the company on the last day.
