





It's Saturday night. You and your friends are planning on having the best night out. A sustainable night out! Write down your ideas for a sustainable night out.

The world is slowly recovering from a pandemic. There is a sense of a new beginning. Write down your ideas for a new sustainable post-pandemic world.






You want to learn - you start to consider how you can inform yourself and others on the matter. Write down your ideas for educating yourself and others on climate change.

You work as a 'facer' for an NGO that focuses on a sustainable world. You have been sent out to get support for the cause: Food Sovereignty, that is the right for everyone to eat healthy food. Write down your ideas for pushing this cause.

You just got invited to a job interview for a job in the research and development unit at a global dairy factory. They ask you to prepare some wild ideas for how to make the dairy industry sustainable. Write down the ideas you have for a sustainable dairy industry.

Without saying it out loud, write down the name of one from the other team to mute. Draw and play out a round with an action! card. When adding the number of ideas, do not include the ideas written by the muted person. The team with most ideas wins the round and advances one square.

The term circular economy is an economic system that works with closed loops where resources are reused over and over. What are the first ideas for a circular business model that comes to mind when you read the definition? Set the timer for 1 minute. Both teams write down as many ideas as possible. The team with most ideas wins the round. The winning team advances to a square in the next line and reads the corresponding card.

The term greenwashing is used when a company mislead people into thinking that the company are more environmentally friendly than they are. What are your ideas on how to avoid greenwashing? Set the timer for 1 minute. Both teams write down as many ideas as possible. The team with most ideas wins the round and advances one square.

With your eyes closed, draw two random ideas (sticky notes) in your idea pile. Show the two sticky-notes to the other team. What new ideas does it give rise to? Set the timer for 1 minute. Both teams write down as many ideas as possible. The team with most ideas wins the round and advances one square.

Draw and play out a round with an action! card. However, both teams must draw their ideas on sticky notes - no writing.



With your eyes closed, draw one idea (one sticky note) from the top and one from the bottom of your idea pile on the game board. Show the two sticky-notes to the other team. Set the timer for 1 minute. Combine the two ideas. What new ideas does it give rise to? Write down as many as possible. The team with most ideas wins the round and advances one square.





















Do a clockwise round of naming vegetables. Set the timer for 1 minute. The team in process of mentioning vegetables when the timer stops loses and the other team can move their token one square forward. You can only mention a vegetable once.

Write down a Haiku poem depicting a sustainable act (in this case, a haiku is a three lined poem with resp. 5, 7 and 5 syllables). Set the timer for 1 minute. The team with most syllables of the Haiku written down on paper/sticky notes after 1 minute wins. The losing team moves back to a square in the previous line and reads the corresponding card.

What are the first ideas that come to mind when you hear about the Sustainable Development Goal 12: responsible consumption and production? Set the timer for 1 minute. Both teams write down as many ideas as possible. The team with most ideas wins the round and advances one square.

Do a clockwise round of naming companies that markets themselves as sustainable (regardless of their actual actions). Set the timer for 1 minute. The team in process of mentioning companies when the timer stops loses and the other team can move their token one square forward. You can only mention a company once.

The term shared economy is used when people share or rent goods instead of buying them. What are your ideas for shared economy? Set the timer for 1 minute. Both teams write down as many ideas as possible. The team with most ideas wins the round and advances one square.

Set the timer for 30 seconds. Both teams write down as many ideas for sustainable living as possible. The team with most unique ideas not written by others - wins the round and advances one square.

Do a clockwise round of naming fruits. Set the timer for 1 minute. The team in process of mentioning new fruits when the timer stops loses and the other team can move their token one square forward. You can only mention a fruit once.

Choose one from the team. This person shall mime a self-chosen sustainable act. Both teams take turn guessing one thing. The first team guessing the act wins the round and advances one square.

While brushing your teeth you let the water run. Move one square back.
