'Building bridges and inclusive boundary communities - How can we as researchers and educators contribute to the formation of inclusive boundary communities without systematically excluding particular groups and individuals?'

How can we provide hope and develop action possibilities as part of collaborative practice research that engages with civil society, social work and education? How can inclusive community-building prevent marginalization and help transcend tendencies towards ethnic and social polarization within contemporary societies? Line Lerche Mørck will present theories, methods and practices of community building, and the development of meaningful methods of documentation as part of the research project 'Community building – developing holistic, community-based preventive approaches'. Holistic and community-based preventive approaches are examined in Hillerød and Nørrebro as prototypical practices, including a focus on how to bridge and produce inclusive collaborations between public authorities (schools, social and employment services), civil society and community organizations.
