### 1 Approval of the agenda

- agenda approved
- BD takes notes, SJ consolidates minutes

### 2 News from the Teaching Coordination Group

- 30% of NAT master/kandidat degrees will in future follow the business-oriented masters degree (75ECTS instead of 120ECTS)
- when courses are discontinued, still three exam attempts need to be possible
- Re-exam period in spring: Pharmacy proposes to reserve the week after Easter for re-examination **Feedback:** The DS TC supports the idea to do this for the whole faculty.
- Choice of electives: too much freedom in choice of electives so the administration requests a reduced drop-down menu. **Concern:** courses on the list have a benefit of being chosen more often compared to other courses that e.g. have never been offered

#### 3 NAT courses for Data Science

- the suitability of courses from LSUL for DS students is discussed:
- we decide to include the courses NAT817 (Oral Science Communication ) and NAT818 (Project management in Science)
- we decide to not include NAT805 (Fagdidaktik, fag og fagsamspil i naturvidenskab) that is designed for teachers
- Task: NAT817 and NAT818 will be added to the list of elective courses in the studieordning

### 4 Human informatics profile

- HUM lacks resources to teach DS819 (Data driven applications) and DS838 (Web development)
- targeted offer is: DS838 in spring (2nd semester) and DS819 in fall (3rd semester)
- IMADA offers to take over DS838, HUM tries to cover DS819

### 5 DS in Kolding

- Tina Ellehuus Larsen requests videos (from the current DS-degree) SJ gives access to corresponding Teams-group
- For the new DS degree in Kolding: we consider to implement some changes compared to the Odense-DS-curriculum wait for approval of Kolding DS before concretizing
- Consider extending the DS-committee by a new member to cover Kolding DS

- Comments from JK: Students from ICT profile not too happy about constitutent electives Maybe evaluating the profiles at the end of the study
- Comments from BD: Might consider some measures to increase communication amongst teachers of DS-degree, especially those from non-IMADA profiles will be discussed further later.
