Minutes

Approval of the agenda and selection of note taker
 The agenda was approved and JLA was selected as note taker.

- 2. Information from the Education Comittee
 - We are expected to continually work on implementing the new pedagogical framework. The coordination group is working on getting a formal introdution to the framework from the faculty to the whole department.
 - The faculty has started a process to transfer responsibility of DM500 to IMADA, starting from this fall. There is a series of meetings at the faculty in the spring, to facilitate this transfer, where JLA and Rolf Fagerberg will participate.
- 3. Information from the Study Board

There has been cases of misinformation about rules for master's theses. We will ensure that students are introduced to the rules in DM800, the study start test.

- 4. Information from IMADAs Teaching Coordination Group
 - The master's reform will affect students starting their bachelor's in fall 2025. We do not yet have the details of exactly how the reform can/should be implemented.
 - IMADA Future will be held on 26 February.
