

Applied Biomechanics Workshop was held on 16-17 November in Kaunas at Lithuanian Academy of Physical Education. Workshop objectives were to bring together the teachers of Biomechanics from the Network Institutions and share good practice in Biomechanics teaching and research.

Workshop participants introduced biomechanics curriculums, programs, issues and research in their institutions, visited Research Center for Fundamental and Clinical Movement Science, Adapted physical activity education and research laboratory in Lithuanian Academy of Physical Education and The Mechatronics Center for Research, Studies and Information in Kaunas University of Technology.

Jan Brondo (University of Southern Denmark) presented a lecture on Improving interdisciplinary education of Anatomy, Biomechanics and Sports Practical using Non-Profit Software. There was a discussion on how to improve interdisciplinary and reach better motivation of students.
