Silvia Regina Rogatto, MSc, PhD, Professor develops research projects in human cancer. She concluded her PhD in Cancer Genetics at University of São Paulo – USP, Brazil in 1990 and complete her postdoctoral at Princess Margaret Hospital, University of Toronto, Canada. Her academic career was developed in Brazil at University of Sao Paulo State (UNESP) and AC Camargo Cancer Center, São Paulo.

In 2016, she moved to Clinical Genetics Department, Vejle Hospital, DK.

During her academic career organized meetings, workshops, congress and International Schools.

Areas of research

Her studies are oriented towards translational research in Human Molecular Cancer Genetics, Genomics and Epigenomics.

The major goal is to provide new information and hypothesis concerning the onset, origin, cancer and therapeutic targets. She conducted research to discovery biomarkers to improve health care through a better understanding of the molecular alterations and pathways involved in human carcinogenesis.

Her main focus is on cancers of breast, colorectal, ovary, and head and neck.

Supervision

She supervised a large number of students (40 MSc, 38 PhD and 16 postdoctoral and more than 35 Bachelors).

Publications

She has published a significant number of articles in indexed journals with relevant impact factor. She received a certificate of merit in 2006 as Eminent Scientist in Cancer Research and Molecular Carcinogenesis.
