In the **short communication** sessions each presenter will have 10 minutes to share a teaching experience and reflections followed by 10 minutes of discussion.

Poster presentations will be in series of 4 posters with 5-minute individual presentations followed by a 20-25-minute joint discussion of the 4 posters.

All abstracts will be peer reviewed prior to acceptance or rejection.
