Aims

- We must continue to give students solid academic and practical skills, and must improve the coherence between the academic and practical courses in the programme.
- We must facilitate our students' transition to work life in the everchanging journalistic field; and prepare the students better for the sociological sides of their internship.
- We must maintain and try to increase the number of students that join and complete a master's degree in journalism.

Actions

- We will finish the implementation of a reform of the programme; introduce a reformed course ahead of the internship, and enhance teaching of untraditional journalistic working fields.
- We will further integrate research in practice-oriented courses and likewise become better at integrating examples, cases etc. from journalism practice in the research-based courses (recurrently).
- We will advertise the master's programme (cand.public.) to current BA students right from the start of the BA programme.
