## Personal experience with "patient" involvement in research:


- In 2008 I wanted to start a national Danish blood donor study
- I was advised to give it up due to anticipated donor resistance
- We instead invited blood donor representatives in to the steering board and received fantastic feed back and support
- Now we have a national study with +110.000 participants

## Patient involvement in health care:
