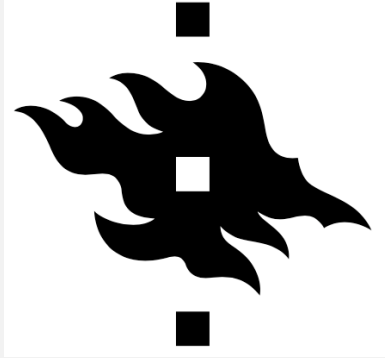

#### Arctic

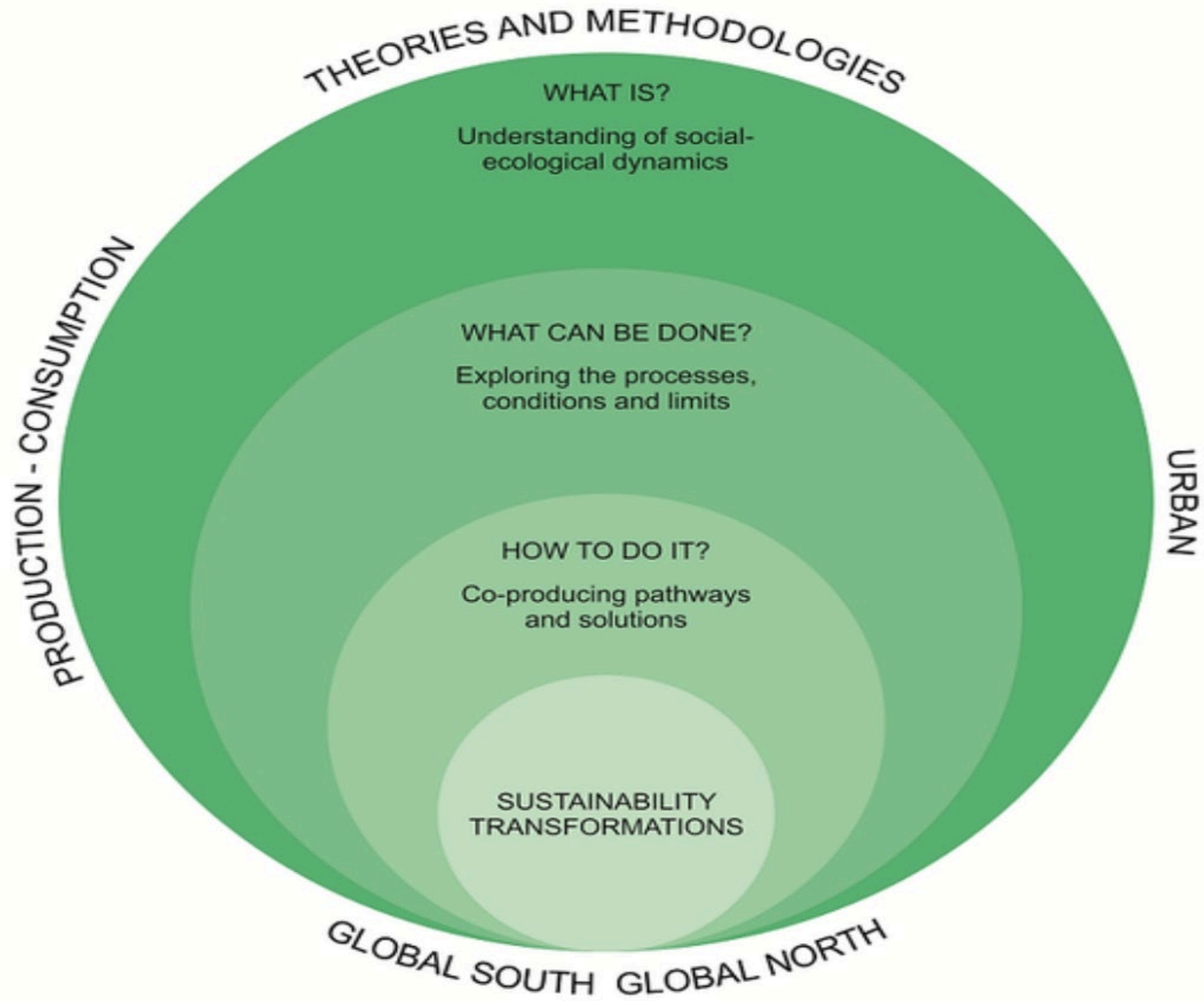
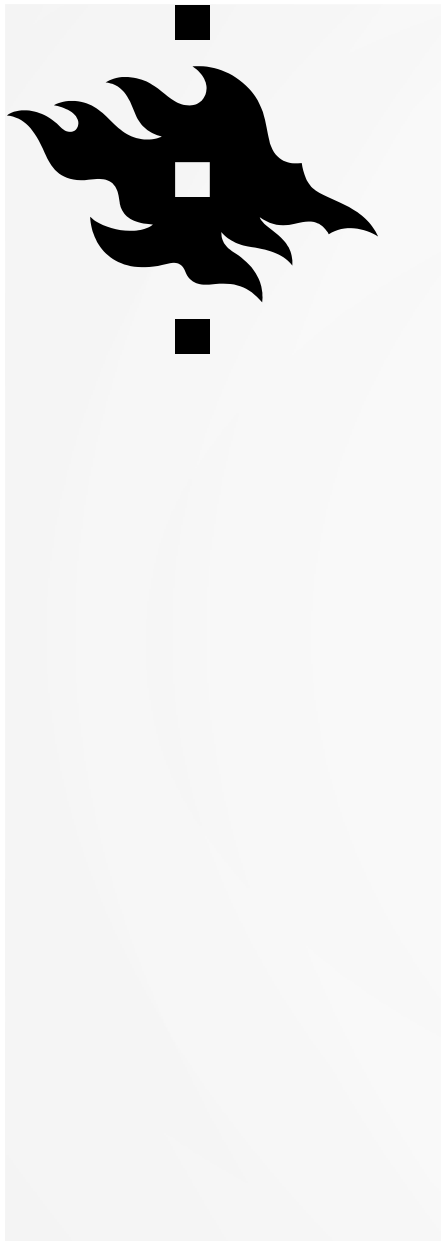
The Arctic region is transforming rapidly. This includes rapid warming, melting ice, and changing ecological conditions that transform...

Urbanized areas cover only a fraction of the Earth's surface but their vast human populations determine the future of our societies...

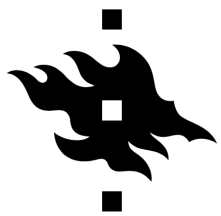
