

Venue & Accommodation Guide

41st Nordic Conference on Law and IT · Odense, Denmark · 21–23 October 2026
Hosted by the Centre for Law, AI and Robotics (CLAIR), University of Southern Denmark

All five venues sit within the compact centre of Odense (Odense C), within walking distance of Odense Station. Each venue below links straight to **Google Maps** for the exact location and directions.

Walking times from the station: First Hotel Grand ~2 min · Brandts ~8 min · H.C. Andersen's House / Deilig ~9 min · Den Gamle Kro ~9 min · Alfred & Kamilla ~13 min (harbour).

The venues

1 · First Hotel Grand PhD workshop · Wed 21 Oct

Jernbanegade 18, 5000 Odense C · ~2 min walk from Odense Station

A classic city hotel a stone's throw from the station. Hosts the pre-conference PhD workshop (11:30–16:30). Registration for the workshop is by e-mail directly to the organiser — not through the conference registration system.

2 · H.C. Andersen's House & Deilig Reception · Wed 21 Oct

H.C. Andersen Haven 3, 5000 Odense C · ~9 min walk from the station

The welcome reception (19:30–21:00) is held at Deilig, the eatery within the acclaimed H.C. Andersen's House museum, in the heart of the fairy-tale quarter. Bubbles and canapés, preceded by a guided tour of the museum. Separate sign-up required.

4 · Brandts Conference day 1 · Thu 22 Oct

Amfipladsen 7, 5000 Odense C (Brandts Klædefabrik) · ~8 min walk from the station

A former textile mill turned vibrant cultural hub with art galleries, cinema and cafés. The full first conference day takes place here; doors open 08:00 with a light breakfast on arrival. Participants have access to all of the museum's exhibitions throughout the day — during the breaks and after the first conference day ends.

5 · Alfred & Kamilla Conference day 2 · Fri 23 Oct

Sverigesgade 16, 5000 Odense C · ~13 min walk from the station

A characterful "chef's house" by the water in Odense's harbour district, with a spacious high-ceilinged hall. Hosts the second conference day, including lunch and the closing sessions.

3 · Den Gamle Kro Conference dinner · Thu 22 Oct

Overgade 23, 5000 Odense C · ~9 min walk from the station

One of Odense's oldest inns (anno 1632), set in atmospheric historic rooms in the old town. The conference dinner is held here from 18:30. Separate registration and payment (added on top of the conference fee).

Where to stay — hotels near the venues

A selection of centrally located hotels, grouped by price level. The \$ symbols indicate the price tier (\$ budget · \$\$ mid-range · \$\$\$ premium), not an official hotel rating. All are within a short walk of the station and the conference venues.

Gertruds Petit Hotel	Thorsgade 31 · by Brandts	\$ from ~600 DKK	Cosy, small-scale, central.
First Hotel Grand	Jernbanegade 18 · by the station	\$\$ from ~750 DKK	Classic city hotel — also the PhD workshop venue.
Milling Hotel Windsor	Vindegade 45 · central	\$\$ from ~720 DKK	Restaurant, bar and buffet breakfast.
Milling Hotel Plaza	Østre Stationsvej 24 · by the station	\$\$ from ~720 DKK	Traditional classic-style city hotel.

Hotel Odeon	Odeons Kvarter 11 · by station & old town	\$\$\$ from ~1,000 DKK	4-star New Nordic design hotel at the ODEON centre; ~5 min to the station.
Aiden by Best Western Odense	Central Odense	\$\$\$ from ~950 DKK	Design-led, relaxed lounge atmosphere.

Indicative "from" prices for a standard double room in late October 2026 (approx., incl. VAT). Prices change frequently — please book early, as October is a busy period in Odense.

Travelling from abroad

By air

The most convenient gateway is **Copenhagen Airport (CPH / Kastrup)**, Scandinavia's largest hub, with direct flights across Europe and beyond. The airport has its own railway station directly beneath the terminal, so you can step off the plane and onto a train to Odense without going into the city first. (Billund Airport, ~1 hour from Odense by bus or car, is a smaller alternative.)

Airport → Odense by train

Trains run 1–2 times per hour from **Copenhagen Airport** to **Odense Station**, taking roughly **1 hour 30 minutes** (the fastest just under 1h30). Some depart directly from the airport; others involve a quick, easy change at Copenhagen Central Station (København H), from where the journey to Odense is about 1h15–1h20. Trains arrive right in the middle of Odense, a short walk from every venue.

Buying your ticket

- Book online or in the app via **DSB** (the national rail operator) at dsb.dk — available in English. International travellers can also use omio.com, an official reseller.
- Tickets are also sold from the **machines and ticket office at the airport station**. A standard ticket can be bought right up to a few minutes before departure — no advance purchase required.
- For the lowest fares, look for **DSB Orange** tickets (limited, tied to a specific train, on sale ~60 days ahead). If your arrival time is uncertain, choose a flexible ticket rather than a non-refundable one.
- A **seat reservation** is optional but recommended in the busy late-October period.

Fares and times are indicative for autumn 2026 and should be checked when booking.

Getting here: Odense Station is on the main line — approx. 1h15 from Copenhagen (and Copenhagen Airport), and well connected to Aarhus. The whole city centre is walkable; local buses and the light rail (Odense Letbane) also serve the area. Questions about venues or accommodation? Contact the organising team via the conference website.
