An increased focus on high quality, evidence-based individualized treatment in psychiatry is supported by the report in 2015 by the Ministry of Health, Ministry for Children, Gender Equality, Integration and Social Affairs (now Ministry of Social Affairs and Senior Citizens), and the Ministry of Higher Education and Science.

Region Zealand established the Center for Evidence-Based Psychiatry (CEBP) in 2018. The main objective of the center is to support and promote evidence-based practice in psychiatry by conducting systematic reviews and meta-analyses.

In this seminar, we will feature a presentation by cand.psych. Maria Quistgaard who will introduce the protocol for her planned PhD project, which aims to combine IPD with Network Meta-Analysis (NMA). Maria is affiliated with the Center for Evidence-Based Psychiatry, Region Zealand. Senior statistician David Fisher from the Medical Research Council Clinical Trials Unit at University College London will discuss the benefits of integrating IPD and NMA methodologies in meta-analysis.
