An increased focus on high quality evidence-based individualized treatment in the psychiatry is supported by the report in 2015 by the Ministry of Health, Ministry for Children, Gender Equality, Integration and Social Affairs (now Ministry of Social Affairs and Senior Citizens), and the Ministry of Higher Education and Science.

Region Zealand established the Center for Evidence-Based Psychiatry (CEBP) in 2018. The main objective of the center is to support and promote evidence-based practice in psychiatry by conducting systematic reviews and meta-analyses.

In this seminar, we will have a presentation on missing data in randomised trials by professor Robin Christensen, from Section for Biostatistics and Evidence-Based Research, the Parker Institute, Copenhagen and University of Southern Denmark. We will also have a presentation by assistant professor Wouter van Ballegooijen, from Department of Clinical Psychology, Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam. Wouter will talk about missing outcome data and meta-analysis.
