IT & Technical preparation

Internet connection

One of the challenges with online meetings is the bandwidth of the participants' connection to the internet. Please note: If one participant has insufficient bandwidth or a bad signal, it will affect the other participants in the meeting.

Here are a few tips:

- All participants should have a minimum speed of 2 Mbit/s on upload and download. For the majority of internet providers, this is the offered minimum. If you would like to check your speed, you can quickly do so on, for example, fast.com or speedtest.net
- If you have the option, you should use a wired connection. This is done by connecting a regular internet cable from your internet router to your computer.
- If you are using a wireless (wi-fi) network, it is essential that you sit as close to your router or access point as possible. Of course, provided that you will still be able to sit in a quiet room.
- As far as possible, make sure that the view to your router or access point is clear. This will ensure that the signal will not be weakened by heavy walls, floor separations, etc.
- Please be aware of the physical location of where you choose to take your oral exam. For example, there is often a weaker internet connection in holiday housing than at the home address.
- Please ask other residents in the house not to stream movies and tv shows while attending the workshop.

Technical issues

When everything is digital, there is of course a risk that software or hardware will fail. Here is a brief review of procedures in case of technical issues or breakdowns.

- If you experience poor connection during the workshop (intermittent image and sound), turn off your camera.
- If you experience resonating sound, echo or feedback, it can often be remedied by putting on a headset. Otherwise, it may help whoever is not speaking mute their microphone.
- Should you drop out of the meeting call, try to get back using the meeting link (URL) provided in the invitation.
- If you cannot get back into the meeting, **contact the technical support office on 0045 6550 2990** for assistance, who will then try to remedy the problem.
