Presentation of Isaaffik/ Peter Schmidt Mikkelsen - Isaaffik

Isaaffik was organized I 2014 at “Hindsgavl”. There are approximately 1200 users. International partners pay equal contributions to the website. This is not an organization who has to “earn” money. The projects from 2017-2021 are presented on the website.

Isaaffik has a collaboration with Arctic Hub and has continuously met with partners to promote and develop the organization. As a researcher you will have the opportunity to share your research, get inspired by other researchers and establish collaborations.
