Dimensions of Counter-Narratives (Working Title)

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Submission deadline One-Page-Abstracts: **1 December, 2017**

Submission deadline for papers based on accepted abstracts: **1 September, 2018**

The Center of Narratological Studies (CNS), SDU Kolding, plans on publishing an edited book with a thematic focus on counter-narratives, to appear in 2019/20. The edited book (publisher agreement pending) will offer a comprehensive outlet for researchers from various disciplines. The CNS, as well as associated and independent researchers, have contributed to numerous scholarly encounters. This book will not only allow for the fruits of these events to reach a larger audience, but also enable interested researchers to contribute novel perspectives and insights connected to the notions “master- and counter-narrative”.

The book welcomes proposals for chapter contributions on a wide array of topics related to the narratological notion of counter-narratives. By way of example, the topic has hitherto been treated by disciplines and subjects such as literary studies, organizational studies, corporate communication and business studies, as well as sociology. The topic may be approached in different ways: We appreciate texts that deal with:

- conceptual questions and contribute to theoretical development
- findings stemming from empirical applications of the counter-narrative concepts, and / or are
- blended text concepts, e.g. comparative perspectives, literature reviews, or grounded theory approaches.

The editors also welcome inquiries by potential contributors who have not yet engaged with the specific notion of counter-narratives, but intend discuss related angles (e.g., from the field of critical discourse analysis, multimodal or thematic analysis, narratology).

On submitting a proposal

Proposals will be peer-reviewed by the editors. Please submit a short and concise abstract of no more than 500 words in English. Please provide a clear headline, and cover the thematic sections purpose, design / methodology / approach, (expected) findings, implications for theory and practice, limitations, and originality and value.
