Rules for distributing income from inventions according to Paragraph 12, Sections 1 and 2 of the Act on inventions at public research institutions

Distribution of income according to Paragraph 12, Section 1

After the University has covered all external costs, the remaining income is distributed with one third to the University, one third to the inventor's Institute and one third to the inventor(s).

If the Patent Committee so advises, the Rector can deviate from this algorithm so that two thirds of the gross income goes to the University and one third to the inventor(s). After the University's external costs are covered, the remaining income is distributed according to the model above.

Distribution of income according to Paragraph 12, Section 2

When the external costs of the inventor(s) have been covered, the remaining income is distributed with 85 percent going to the inventor(s) and 15 percent to the University.

To the extent that the University has had external costs, these are covered in the same way as those of the inventor(s).
