General objectives	The module aims to give the students the understanding of the theoretical, methodological and practical challenges as well as the basic skills to take into account the cultural and social context in carrying out evidence-based public health research both on global themes and in international collaboration related to multi-centre studies. Examples of global challenges are: health policies and inequity and health; public health preparedness and action in coping with emerging epidemics; and research ethics in the global context e.g. in carrying out drug trials or marketing tobacco in low income countries; and contextual research on illness perceptions, behaviours and communication. Further, the international and global health research systems, funding resources, priority settings processes and institutions and covered.
