## 1. Minutes from the last meeting

## 2. Action plan for internalisation

• International recruitment, by Bo Kristiansen and Yulia Tinyakova

Bo Kristiansen will shortly tell about recruitment strategy at SDU. UIU members are asked to consider possible questions concerning full-degree students' recruitment to BSS-SDU both from and outside the EU.

Ole will inform UIU members about the visit from Chinese partner, and thoughts on recruitment from this and other universities in China.

Summer school initiative

Yulia will shortly inform about international summer school UIU discussed during last meeting. UIU will be asked to discuss possibilities for arranging a bigger summer school in summer 2016 or 2017, and whether BSS-SDU should put efforts into this project.

  - 1. 'Study packages' for out-going students, Yulia an example from Kolding, Annex 2 Shall faculty put more effort into establishing 'study packages' for all study programmes? If yes, how these 'examples' shall be communicated to students?
    - 2. Maximum/minimum number of ECTS points for study period abroad. Shall BSS-SDU have common frames for number of ECTS pre-acknowledged for Study Abroad Period?

- In-coming exchange students
  - 1. BSS-SDU should give places in classes to in-coming exchange students in order to be able to send our own students as well secure that we can keep the amount of places at our partner universities. A number of study boards try to limit this amount of places for in-coming students due to different reasons. UIU is asked to consider and discuss this problem;
  - 2. Numbers of in-coming exchange students are considerably lower than it used to be previous years. This is, above other reasons, due to marketing and promotion of our courses to SDU partners. Partners are not informed of the possibilities at SDU. On a longer run this can result termination of some the agreements. UIU is asked to consider and discuss this problem.
