- **Horizon 2020 calls have been launched**

All calls are published on the [European Commissions' Participant Portal](#).

- **The EUopSTART calls have been launched**

EUopSTART provides grants to Danish companies and research institutions who are preparing a proposal for the new framework programme for research and innovation Horizon 2020. You have to co-finance 50 percent and you can receive up to 150.000 DKK for the preparation of an application.

EUopSTART aims to intensify the internalization of Danish research and strengthen the interaction between research institutions and companies engaged in research and innovation.

Grants will be given to applications that are beneficial for Danish research and innovation. There is no application deadline but there is a limited amount of grants. Please find EUopSTART call for 2014 [here](#).

Funding opportunities

- **The 2nd joint call for transnational research projects of the ANIHWA ERA-Net initiative**

The Danish Council for Strategic Research (DSF) is a partner in the European ERA-NET Coordination of European Research on Animal Health and Welfare (ANIHWA). DSF has allocated 0.5 million Euro to Danish participation in the call.

At least three ANIHWA partner countries must be included in the collaboration.

[The call](#) includes the following 4 topics:

1. Promoting research integrating animal health and welfare: development of animal-based indicators of animal health and welfare, development and implementation of new husbandry systems ensuring good health and welfare.
2. Development of knowledge which may lead to new or improved tools for diagnosis and disease prevention, including vaccines.
3. Improvement of preparedness for emerging and exotic diseases (including vector-borne diseases and zoonoses) by an epidemiological approach to risk pathways identification.
4. Antimicrobial and anthelmintic resistance and development of alternative curative and preventive therapies.

- **PhD Fellowships**

[The Boehringer Ingelheim Fonds](#) awards PhD fellowships to outstanding junior scientists (max. age: 27 years) who wish to pursue an ambitious PhD project of approximately 3 years in basic biomedical research in an internationally leading laboratory. The fellowship comprises a competitive monthly stipend that is initially granted for 2 years and that can be extended for up to another 12 months. Participation in international scientific conferences is also supported. In addition, fellowship holders are offered personal support, seminars to discuss their projects, communication training and alumni meetings, and thus can become part of a worldwide network.
