**72 million kr. on the way to sustainable, green urban development**

Erhvervsstyrelsen has set up a committee to distribute approximately 72 million. kr. from EU's Regionalfond to develop sustainable green solutions in large Danish cities. Municipalities with cities that have over 30,000 inhabitants can seek funding. - **First transnational call for research projects within ERA-MarineBiotech**

The first transnational joint call for research projects within the framework of ERA-MarineBiotech aims to stimulate joint European research and development activities in marine biotechnology. The aim of this call is to bring together basic, applied, technology and market driven research approaches to enhance and develop efficient and sustainable biorefinery processes for marine bioresources. Transnational research consortia from academia, research institutes and industry are invited to submit proposals that develop new and/or improved biotechnological knowledge, tools and methods for the sustainable processing of marine biomass into a variety of bio-based products and/or services. This is best achieved through integrated biorefinery processes ideally utilising all molecular fractions present in the relevant biomass.

Funding will be granted for a maximum of three years according to national regulations. Submissions of proposals will be in two steps - a pre-proposal step and a full proposal step for invited consortia.

An [Industrial PhD project](#) is a three-year industrially focused PhD project conducted in collaboration between a company, a university and an Industrial PhD candidate. The Industrial PhD candidate is employed by the company and enrolled at the university at the same time. The candidate spends all his/her working time on the research project and PhD education, and divides the working time between the company and the university.

- **Eurostars**

Eurostars is a market oriented R&I programme for SME's. But research institutions and other enterprises can also participate.

Eurostars is a market oriented bottom-up programme. At least two partners from two Eurostars participating states must participate in a project. At least 50% of the work load in project must be conducted by the participating research intensive SME's. A Eurostars project can last up to a maximum of three years and a product or a service must be ready for market introduction no later than two years after the conclusion of the Eurostars-project.
