Public sector Industrial PhD with subsidy

The <u>InnovationFoundation</u> has decided to allocate funding for 10 public sector Industrial PhD projects. An Industrial PhD project is a PhD education where the student is employed in a private sector company and at the same time enrolled at a university while working on the same project both places. **Deadline: October 13, 2014**

• Forskerudvekslingsaftale med Japan

Forskningsophold, der finder sted i tidsrummet i Japan 1. april 2015 - 31. marts 2016. Aftalen omfatter følgende støttemuligheder:

• Nordic Innovation Programme - Nordic Built

Nordic Built is a joint Nordic initiative of the Nordic ministers for trade and industry to accelerate Nordic competitive concepts for a sustainable built environment.

- The following types of projects can obtain funding through <u>this call for proposals</u>: - New sustainable building or refurbishment concepts
 - New innovative and sustainable business models for new buildings and for refurbishment of existing buildings
 - Projects that generally promote the Nordic Built Charter or generally promote Nordic cooperation within sustainable building

For a project to receive funding under this call for proposals, these basic eligibility criteria (among others) must be met:

- The project must include partners form at least three Nordic countries with a reasonable balance between the different nations.
- No more than 50% of the budget can come from public funding

Deadline: October 15, 2014

• EXPLORATORY PRE-SEED GRANTS (Novo Nordisk)

The exploratory pre-seed program is a stimulus fund established to accelerate commercialization of biomedical research findings and development of novel technologies within the life sciences. The goal of an exploratory pre-seed grant is to stimulate entrepreneurship and to explore the potential of research findings at a very early stage (pre-seed), and to prepare the project for a full pre-seed grant at a later stage. Thus, the program seeks to support application-oriented research and to test new ideas that may lead to the development of new medical treatments, disease prevention, devices and diagnostic methods as well as new industrial biotechnology in the life science area. Normally grants can support activities costing from DKK 100,000 to DKK 500,000 during a grant period of 4-12 months. **Deadline: October 16, 2014**

• LIFE Action Grants

The LIFE Regulation on the establishment of the Programme for Environment and Climate Action, sets a budget for the next funding period, 2014-2020, of 3.4 billion Euro. The Commission invites legal persons (entities) registered in the European Union (EU) to present proposals for the 2014 <u>Call for proposals for LIFE Action Grants</u>. The call covers proposals for both LIFE sub-programmes.

Deadline: medio October, 2014 (please find the specific deadlines for the different programmes in the call)

• Novo Scholarship Programme 2015

Novo Nordisk and Novozymes offer scholarships to support graduate training of some of the best students in protein science, biotechnology, bioinformatics, molecular biology, systems biology, translational medicine, microbiology, biophysics, pharmacology, drug delivery and biomedical devices. The purpose is to allow selected students at universities in Denmark and Lund University to devote full time to their MSc thesis (in Danish: speciale, kandidatspeciale).

Students enrolled at a Danish university or Lund University at the time of submitting the application can apply. The university supervisor must be associated with the same institution. Marks for bachelor project, if part of the curriculum must be at least 10 and weighted average for the bachelor minimum 8.2 (7-point scale). The student may spend some time during the MSc thesis project at an institution outside the university such as Novo Nordisk/Novozymes R&D labs or an institution abroad. The scholarship amounts to DKK 7,000 per month for up to 12 months at a maximum of DKK 84,000 for a one year MSc thesis project. The scholarship can be initiated anytime between 1 February, 2015 and 1 September, 2015. Application form can be obtained from Shirley Wong(SWYW@novonordisk.com).

• Research projects - science and technology – The Willum foundation

VILLUM FONDEN supports research activities, especially within science and technology. For this programme, the Foundation awards grants only for major research projects with a budget on more than 0.5 mio. DKK. A typical project budget is 2-6 mio. DKK. over 3 years. The grants are made to cover salaries for Ph.D., postdocs, technical assistance (not permanently employed staff), operating expenses and procurement of major equipment for research purposes, especially in the case of pioneering research. To a limited extent, and based on a transparent budget, the Foundation will be ready to cover overhead costs directly related to the project concerned. Applicants must have a permanent position at a university or research institution. Financial support to research projects does not include research areas in health science, medicine and biomedicine.
