Submissions are invited for the 4th Annual Meeting of the Danish Society for Economic and Social History, which will take place at the Sønderborg campus of the University of Southern Denmark from September 19-20, 2018. The theme of the meeting is 'Regions in Economic History' and is in conjunction with the 3rd annual SDU workshop on 'Urban, Regional and International Economics'.

This aims at bringing together researchers interested in studying the spatial determinants and implications of various kinds of economic interactions. Relevant topics include (but are not limited to) the analysis of trade flows and factor mobility, spatial business location and economic growth processes as well as the spatial implications of public policies. Contributions dealing with the historical dimension of urban, regional and international economics are particularly welcome.

Please note that although papers on Danish and Nordic economic and social history, as well as the theme of 'Regions in Economic History' are particularly encouraged, *all* topics are welcome. The language of the meeting will be English.

The Danish Society for Economic and Social History (<u>https://sites.google.com/site/danishsocietyesh/</u>) aims to promote the study of economic and social history in Denmark, as well as scholars in Denmark and abroad working on Danish economic and social history.

There will be a registration fee of ≤ 100 for this meeting, or ≤ 70 for members of the Danish Society for Economic and Social History (≤ 20 for graduate students who are also members of the Society). Lunch and refreshments will be provided throughout the meeting, and there will be a dinner on the evening of the first day.
